SWEDEN

FLAG	<i>The flag consists of a yellow or gold Nordic Cross, an asymmetrical horizontal cross, on a field of blue</i>
POPULATION	<i>The total population of Sweden was estimated to be (9,845,155)</i> <i>About 85% of the population live in urban areas</i> Official languages <i>The official language is Swedish</i> Immigration <i>Most immigrants are Iraqi</i> Religion <i>Most Swedish people practice Lutheran Christianity</i>
ECONOMY	<i>The economy is based on:</i> Primary sector: <i>the most important products are potatoes, wheat, milk and dairy products, minerals, wood from the forests.</i> <i>Only 6% of the country is cultivable, but the production is elevated.</i> <i>There are many livestock of bovines</i> Secondary sector: <i>the secondary sector is based on nuclear energy, hydroelectric power stations, automotive industry, e.g. Volvo, arms, white goods/household industry, Electrolux, telecommunications, Ericsson, pharmaceutical industry</i> Tertiary sector: <i>it is represented by the mass/large-scale distribution, e.g. IKEA and H&M</i>
POSITION	<i>Sweden is in the North of Europe, between Norway and Finland</i>
TYPICAL FOOD	<i>Fish, meat and potatoes.</i> <i>Famous preparations include Swedish meatballs, traditionally served with gravy, boiled potatoes and lingonberry jam.</i> <i>The traditional flat and dry crisp bread has developed into several contemporary variants.</i>

MOUNTAINS	<p><i>The highest mountains are the Scandinavian mountain range, that separates Sweden from Norway.</i></p> <p><i>The mountains aren't very high and sharp, due to the erosion of permanent ices / permafrost</i></p>

CLIMATE	<p><i>The Norwegian climate is continental in the inner parts, the coastal climate is oceanic, the north as a polar climate.</i></p>
ETHNIC GROUPS	<p><i>The ethnic groups are forest finns and lapps</i></p>
CAPITAL CITY	<p><i>The capital city of Norway is Oslo.</i></p> <p><i>Other important cities are Bergen, Trondheim and Stavanger</i></p>
BORDERS	<p><i>It borders Arctic ocean to the north, Finland and Russia to the north-east, Finland to the east, the North Sea to the south and Norwegian sea to the west</i></p>
TERRITORY	<p><i>The rugged coastline, broken by huge fjords and thousands of islands, stretches 25,000 km.</i></p> <p><i>Fjords are deep grooves cut into the land.</i></p> <p><i>Permafrost is ground, at or below the freezing point of water 0° C for two or more years.</i></p>
RIVERS/LAKES	<p><i>The rivers are short and impetuous.</i></p> <p><i>There are many small lakes, Hornindalsvatnet is the deepest lake in all Europe.</i></p>
